

Approximate loss of a fiber optic splice box



Overview

Acceptable splice loss in optical fiber is typically considered to be less than 0. The primary contributors to measured splice loss are fiber material and design factors that. To be able to judge whether a fiber optic cable plant is good, one does a insertion loss test with a light source and power meter and compares that to an estimate of what is a reasonable loss for that cable plant. The estimate, called a "loss budget" is calculated using typical component losses for. Splice loss occurs whenever the mode fields of two joined fibers do not perfectly overlap. In single-mode fibers, light travels as a Gaussian beam. This tool uses the Marcuse Gaussian Approximation to calculate losses from intrinsic mismatch and extrinsic alignment errors. The total loss in decibels at the fusion splice is given by the following equation, where P_{in} is the total power incident on the fusion splice and P_{trans} is the. 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Multimode Splice Loss

When splicing similar fibers, typical splice loss values (less than 0.1dB fusion or 0.2 dB mechanical) are expected. However, when splicing dissimilar fibers, additional factors must be taken into account
