

# Distance requirements between industrial facilities and distribution boxes



## Overview

The distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should not exceed 3 meters. This proximity principle reduces line losses and improves power.
