Key Insight: DR Congo's fiber optic infrastructure is expanding rapidly, with coverage reaching 45% in 2026, significantly improving internet access in urban and rural areas. Internet penetration has grown to 36%, driven by mobile adoption and government initiatives to enhance digital connectivity.
