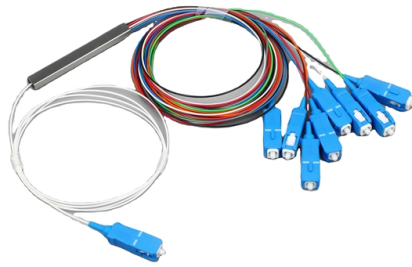


Do the two wires of the optical module need to be crossed



Overview

If the fibers are not crossed in the permanent cable plant, one duplex patch cord in the link needs to be crossed or simplex patch cords can be used and the proper connections made manually. My advice is to pick one side (probably the MDF distribution) and install your crossover cables there. Of course in practice I usually just see people flip polarity randomly until it starts working. One of the most common faults when a newly-installed fiber network does not work is the fibers are not. Fiber optics relies on a bidirectional transmission where the transmitter port on one end connects to the receiver port on the other end. Because of this B to A and A to B connection, it is referred to as Cross-Over since the A position crosses over to the B, and vice versa.
