

# Does the secondary fiber distribution box need repeated grounding

Grounding and Bonding: The box should be properly grounded to prevent electrical shocks and ensure system integrity. This Applications Engineering Note (AE Note) discusses conventional bonding and grounding practices for conductive fiber optic cable and hardware installations within the scope of the National Electrical Code (NEC). Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm<sup>2</sup> (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm<sup>2</sup> must be used.
