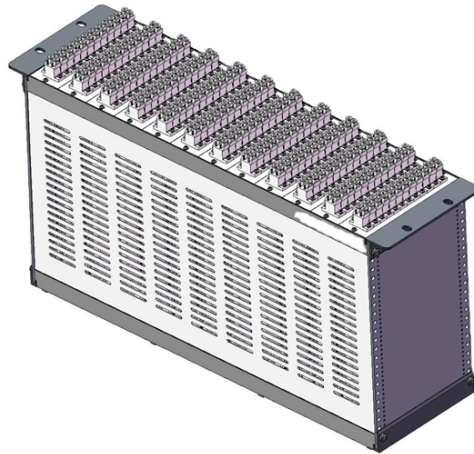


How to connect a single-mode fiber optic transceiver to a switch



Overview

Insert a compatible SFP transceiver into the converter's port, making sure it matches the network's media type and speed. Then, connect one end of the fiber cable to the transceiver and the other to the appropriate port on a switch, router, or another media converter.
