

# Mali Mobile Broadband Fiber Optic Cable



## Overview

Mobile network operators (MNOs) have deployed broadband in major cities. Orange announced the commissioning and commercial launch of Djoliba, the first pan-African backbone network, covering 8 countries: Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, Guinea, Liberia, Mali, Nigeria and Senegal. This Djoliba network infrastructure is based on a terrestrial fibre optic network. Key Insight: Mali's fiber optic infrastructure is expanding steadily, reaching approximately 35% coverage in 2026, driven by government initiatives and private sector investments. Internet penetration remains modest at 28%, reflecting ongoing challenges but promising growth opportunities. While submarine communications cables are used to connect countries and continents to the Internet, terrestrial fibre optic cables are used to extend this connectivity to landlocked countries or to urban centers within a country.
