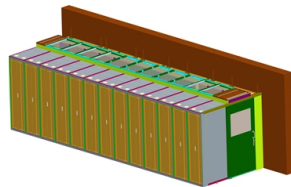


Meaning of undertaking optical cable

Optical fiber consists of a core and a cladding layer, selected for due to the difference in the refractive index.
