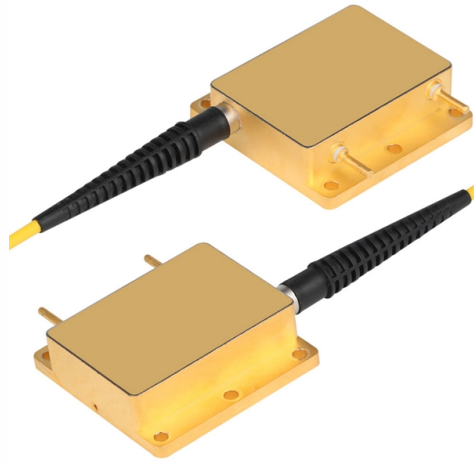


Plug the pigtail into the box



Overview

Connect the pigtail wire to the electrical outlet or end device by tightening it with a screw. But you have to loop the bare wire around the screw terminal first. Some of these connections require soldering or crimping, so apply the appropriate action. It's a small detail with a big impact on your electrical setup. This guide provides a.
