

Requirements for the height of overhead distribution boxes



Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4 feet high. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid being tripped over. The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience.
