

Should power and signal lines be routed through fire cable trays



Overview

Segregation of Power and Signal Cables: Power (high-voltage) and signal (low-voltage) cables should be routed separately, using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference. Tray Type and Material Selection Indoor: Painted steel or galvanized trays. Outdoor: Hot-dip galvanized or. Recognize electrical cable tray misuse that can lead to electric shock and arc-flash/blast events and fires caused by overheating. 305(a)(3), or comparable standards promulgated by States. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require. Poorly fitted trays may serve as a fuse in case of a short or a top chimney in case of a fire. The commissioning agents for the project have recently told us that this is against code, however in speaking with our fire alarm subcontractor they do not believe that to be the case -.
