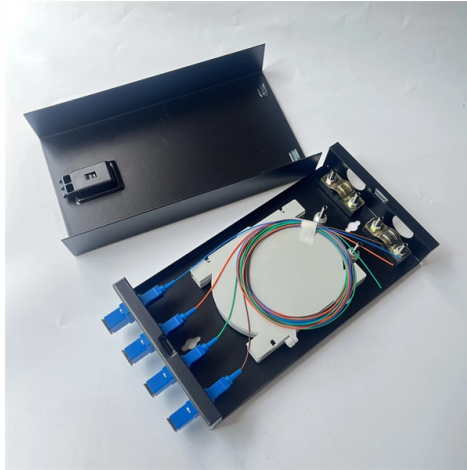


What is the appropriate curing temperature for fiber optic pigtails
