

Yemen has no electricity



Overview

ADEN, May 13 (YPA) – Yemen's southern port city of Aden, controlled by Saudi-backed forces, is witnessing record-long power outages amid a near-total collapse of the electricity system and growing public anger over deteriorating living conditions. Years of ongoing conflict in Yemen has led to a catastrophic humanitarian crisis. Blackouts lasting up to 20 hours per day, coupled with extreme climate-induced heat surpassing 40°C, are not only. From the suspension of Mareb power station from the national grid to the suspension of oil and gas production, Yemen remains among the world's lowest per capita electricity producers. The complexities of electricity generation, distribution, and optimization require commitment to bringing knowledge. Yemen's first large-scale solar power plant is offering much-needed relief to Aden, a city long plagued by electricity shortages that intensify during the summer heat. But as the price of diesel skyrocketed over the years, regular access to electricity has moved out of reach for many Yemenis.
